

## **Parish Commendation**

The following form is to be completed by the incumbent and four lay persons of the parish of congregation in which a prospective postulant has been an active participant for at least one year. Normally the wardens and two additional persons who are particularly familiar with the strengths and limitations of the prospective postulant comprise the group of lay persons. The information in the form should represent the considered opinion of the five persons. This information will be used by the Bishop and her advisors, including the Secretary and Assessors of the Advisory Committee on Postulants for Ordination (ACPO). It is strongly recommended that the persons completing this form be familiar with the document entitled "Ordination Prerequisites" in the Anglican Church of Canada. This document outlines the procedures leading toward ordination in this Church, approved by the House of Bishops.

The completed form is to be sent to the Synod Office of the Prospective Postulant.
