The real mystery is: What is it that actually keeps the villagers from leaving? When her betrothed is stricken by a greater human evil from within their midst, the most innocent and vulnerable villager must venture forth to the outside world for medicine to save his life. <p>A paramedic ambulance driver is driven to the edge of sleep deprivation and emotional trauma by being forced to work extended shifts on his job -- to fetch and bring in to the emergency room the victims of every kind of human folly and violent crime. Not only his physical and mental strength, but also his faith and compassion are tested to the limit, but through the numbness, the hopelessness and the horror, the purest and most Godly part of him and others shines through in the end.
