

The “New” Resource Centre

In September 2003, the old Resource Centre collection was partially damaged by water leakage from Hurricane Juan. This “blessing in disguise” led to the creation of the present Resource Centre for use by clergy and laypersons of the whole Diocese. New furniture and metal shelving, audiovisual and computer equipment make the space more inviting and user-friendly.

This year, two new sections were started: CDs of recorded music and DVD dramas with a spiritual component.
