Where are we going?

- **Anglicans with a theology of abundance**
- **All parishes with sustainable, parish-based stewardship**
- **Strong regional stewardship leaders**
- **A diocese of healthy, viable congregations**

How will we get there?

- Begin with 3 pilot regions
 - ◆ All parishes willing to send 2 lay leaders for training
 - ◆ Willing to test first 2 modules, help evaluate and rework for parish effectiveness

How will we get there?

- Build an atmosphere of collegiality
 - ◆ Willingness to share stories and resources
 - ◆ Training and working together on a regional basis

How will we get there?

- Identify the talents of our people
- Provide opportunities for people to use their gifts in God's service
